## APPLICATION

THE DATA PRESENTED HEREIN IS PUBLISHED, POSTED AND FILED FOR THE FOLLOWING REASONS, viz.:-

- To comply with the order of the Interstate Commerce Commission dated January 9, 1912.
- To afford a complete filing as is required by Section 6 of The Interstate Commerce Act.
- To confirm and complete references in Classifications and Tariffs of Rates.
- To give the Commission and the public full information from the tariffs themselves without having to examine the equipment itself as to complete description of cars used to transport freight including each physical characteristic which may in any way determine or affect the charge or the value of the service rendered by the carrier, viz.:-

**UNDER THE TERM "DIMENSIONS":** Inside length, width and height, in feet and inches (See Note); location and size of door openings. Platform measurements of flat cars appear in columns under heading "Inside" dimensions.

NOTE—In computing inside length, width and height, in feet and inches, fractions of inches must be omitted.

**UNDER THE TERM "CAPACITY":** "Marked Capacity," (nominal capacity or truck capacity) as provided in standard operating and mechanical rules of the railways or an arbitrary selected from a safety standpoint within reasonable physical limit of the vehicle.

NOTE—Where reference is made to this tariff for "Marked Capacity" of cars, the capacity published in this tariff will be considered the "Marked Capacity".

**UNDER CUBICAL CAPACITY:** Cubical capacity "Cubic feet level full" of all cars except flat cars and tank cars designed for carrying liquids. This detail (cubical capacity in feet) is shown for tank cars designed for carrying other than liquids.

**UNDER "CAPACITY OF ICE TANKS":** "Depth" and "cubic feet" capacity of ice bunkers or brine tanks in refrigerator cars, capacity of such bunkers or brine tanks in pounds of ice of the sizes usually furnished at icing stations known generally as "crushed", "coarse" or "chunk" ice.

**UNDER "MARKINGS AND KIND OF CARS" AND "NUMBERS":** Ownership marks, class and type of car ("A. A. R. Mechanical [or M. C. B.] Designation" indicating physical characteristics in detail), car number, or if the number is one of a series built on one set of specifications, the beginning number and the ending number of each series. The number of cars contained in each series appears in column at extreme right, under heading "No." or "Number of Cars."

**UNDER "FREIGHT CONNECTIONS AND JUNCTION POINTS"** in registration of each carrier: A list of connecting carriers arranged alphabetically by name of carrier and junction point at which interchange is effected. (See Note).

NOTE—Association of American Railroads—Definition of "Direct Connection":

All lines interchanging cars at a common point, or within switching limits either over their own rails or through an intermediate line or lines or via a car ferry or float within such switching limits, shall be considered direct connections\* \* \*

This information should be published in The Official Railway Equipment Register, and when the interchange is other than over their own rails the channel through which interchange is effected must be shown.
